# Get Ready to Read

## READING GOAL: Skim for Gist

*Gist* is what a text is mostly about. To find the gist, you can read a text quickly. This is called *skimming*. Before you read, skim the text. Look at the title, the first sentence of each paragraph, and the pictures.

# Painting Fun in the Sun

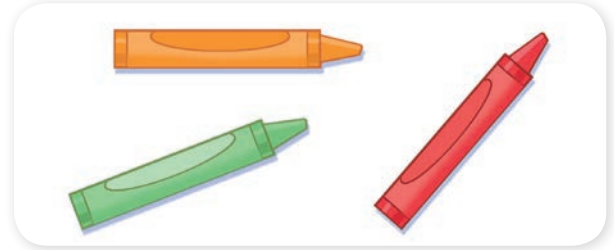

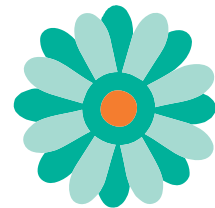

### A Read the description. Underline the details.



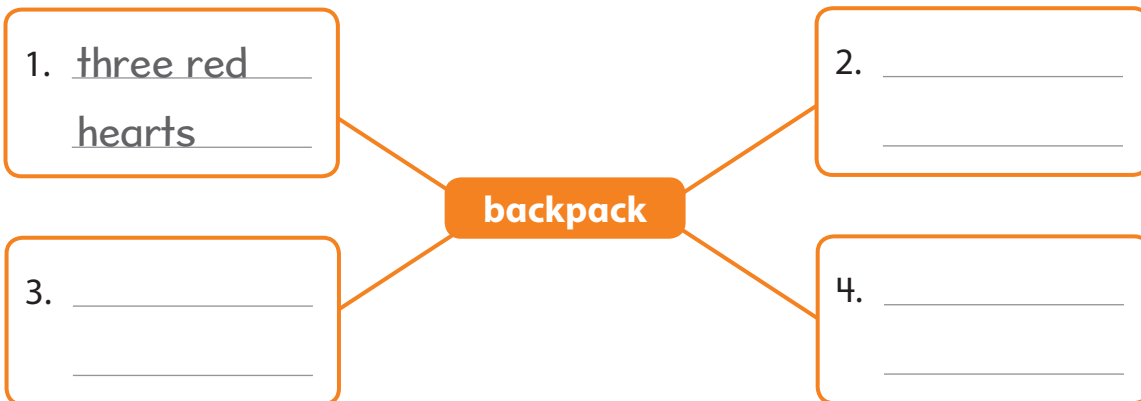
#### Writing Tip

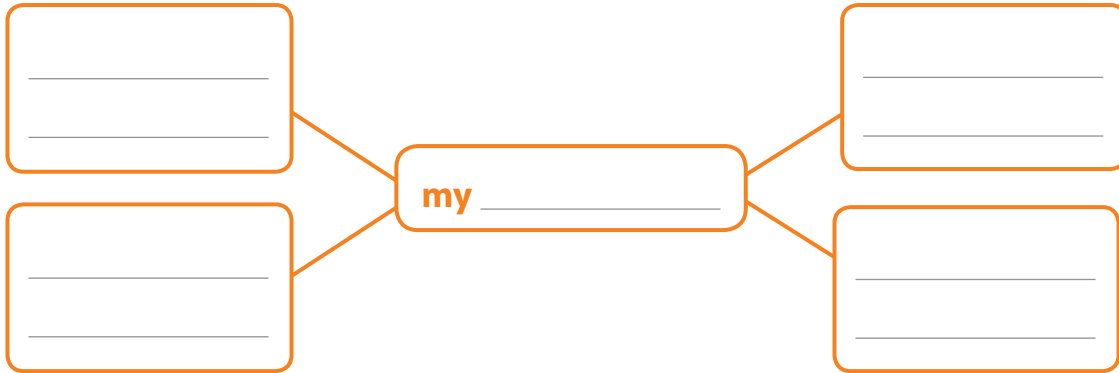
